CONCERT CHOIR TO TOUR FLORIDA

Exeter's acclaimed Concert Choir will travel to Florida for its spring concert tour, March 14 to 19.

The choir's program will include *A Procession Winding Around Me*, settings of Walt Whitman poems by composer Jeffrey Van; David Conte's *The Waking*; John Tavener's *Village Wedding*; and folk songs from Bulgaria and Cuba. The choir will be joined by a string trio for Georg Telemann's *Laudate Jehovam* and by members of the African Drumming Ensemble for three Nigerian works for choir and drums.

The Concert Choir is a 40-voice mixed choir whose members hail from all parts of the world. Under the direction of Stephen Kushner—who was appointed director of choral music in 1987, chair of the music department in 1995 and director of studies in 1999—the choir has toured regularly, premiered several new works and released five compact disc recordings, most recently *Sing On, Sing On, Sing On*, released last spring. Composer Robert Convery has said of the choir's recordings, "The pure sound and perfect discipline of the Concert Choir shine through as an unforgettable musical gift."
